The project looks into equipping SMEs (especially micro and small enterprises) with a set of tools and practices that will help them acknowledge and reap the benefits of including people with disabilities in their workforce.

Provides e-learning material to persons with disabilities, based on which they will be able to better demonstrate, acquire/further develop job skills (including job seeking skills, self-marketing, job expectations, self-presentation skills), as well as transferable soft skills for professional development at the work-place.
